Workshop Objectives

The MARISA project started on May 2017 with a twofold objective:

- deliver a toolkit providing a suite of services to correlate and fuse various heterogeneous and homogeneous data and information from different sources and to improve information exchange, situational awareness, decision-making and reaction capabilities;
- support the cooperation among different Member States and User communities, providing networking and infrastructural services and adopting the CISE data model as the basis for the definition of the MARISA data model.

Now that we are approaching the end of the project we would like to share with the MARISA user community the major achievements and open a discussion on the exploitation of such a system.

This 3rd MARISA Workshop will take place after the Operational Trials execution with the following main objectives:

- to present the MARISA Toolkit services implemented in Phase-2 of the project and the results of the second and final campaign of MARISA operational trials opening a discussion on whether the MARISA toolkit could contribute to:
 - improve and extend maritime border situational awareness;
 - improve operational support to Search and Rescue activities;
 - reduce death at sea while contrasting irregular immigration and cross border crime.
- to present the status of the exploitation and standardization activities in MARISA and open a discussion with the stakeholders concerning the future use of the MARISA toolkit.
